Rifle Range Shooting: Damage has been done recently to newly installed yardage signs and trees along the rifle ranges. This is a serious Safety issue as well as damaging club property. For those responsible you know who you are and you can loose your shooting rights or membership so stop. All shooting on ranges must be directed towards the mounds designed to stop the bullets. Shooting left, right, above and below mounds presents a Safety issue. Please do not use clay target on rifle or pistol ranges.

Also shooting across club drives is prohibited, this includes shooting with shotguns from Field Trial area or while hunting.

For those using the ranges a reminder that whatever you bring with you to shoot at must be removed when you leave. Do not expect someone else to clean up after you.

The Board of Trustees has directed that No paintballs gun will be allowed on the ranges, this is due to the mess left behind by someone shooting on the pistol bays and in the parking lot.

The Ranges will be closed as in the past for the first two days of Deer gun season, Nov. 30th & Dec.1st.
