In addition to the new trap facilities we are hoping to form a Team to shoot in the fall Ashtabula county Trap league this year. The fall league rotates thru various sportsman clubs in the county and shoots a basic program on Saturdays for 6 to 8 weeks in the fall. Persons of all shooting levels are welcome to participate in this trap league.

Also this summer as part of Crooked Creeks continued commitment to the youth segment, We are going to schedule several youth days on a Saturday(s) August 13 and September 17. Member's children ages 10 to 15 as well as non-members may shoot from 10:00am to 2:00pm on these days. The Trap, Skeet and Five stand will be open for the youth to learn basics and improve there shooting abilities. Club range officers will be on-site to assist the youth. We cordially request that parents may stay and watch but do not provide assistance or advice to the youth during their scheduled time on the range. The cost per round (25 targets) will be \$2.00 on scheduled youth days. Parents are welcome to shoot after the youth have had their time on the range.
