CLUB DUES for 2012: If your club dues were received, included in this mailing is your new membership card and stickers. Remember, the Board of Trustees approved a \$25 Late Fee if your dues were not received by February 28, 2012.

**THE ANNUAL MEETING:** The clubs annual membership meeting was held on February 12, 2012 There was good attendance by club members. The ODNR gave an update on hunting seasons and licensing requirements. Committee reports were given. President, Dennis Meinke, reviewed all the progress made on improving club facilities and grounds in 2011as well as plans for future projects in mind for 2012. Dennis informed the membership on details on clear cutting of trees on a 10 acre and a selective cutting of 150 trees near 100 yard range. Tree cutting netted the club \$76,951. We had a new metal roof with extensions installed on the Main Clubhouse. We developed a plan to rebuild and enlarge the Duck pond north of FT grounds. Received Grants from ODNR for \$1,500 and US Fish and Wildlife Service for \$2,500 which paid for this project. We now have 2.5 acre pond. We put in a parking lot, installed Club signs and gate on the new property we purchased in late 2010 this property will be known as the Shaughnessy Woods.

Crooked Creek has been awarded Conservation Club Of the Year By the Ohio State NWTF Board Of Directors for 2011.

Elections of Trustees were held.

Member's children ages 10 to 15 as well as non-members may shoot from 11:00am to 1:00pm on the days these shoots will be scheduled. More to come on the dates once we finalize this program. The Trap, Skeet and Five stand will be open for the youth to learn basics and improve their shooting abilities. Club range officers will be on-site to assist the youth. We cordially request that parents may stay and watch but do not provide assistance or advice to the youth during their scheduled time on the range. The cost per round (25 targets) will be \$2.00 on the scheduled youth days. Parents are welcome to shoot after the youth have had their time on the range. Price per round for parents will be \$3.00 members as well as non-members.
