Fee Increase for Clay Targets

As of June 1, clay target fees have increased to \$4.00 for members and \$5.00 for non-members, due to the current and projected increases in costs of clay targets. Most clubs in the area are charging fees which equal or exceed our new fees, and it's reasonable to expect that all clubs will increase their fees as prices for clay targets rise.
