As of June 1, clay target fees have increased to \$4.00 for members, and \$5.00 for non-members, due to the current and projected increases in costs of clay targets. Most clubs in the area are charging fees which equal or exceed our new fees, and it's reasonable to expect that all clubs will increase their fees as prices for clay targets rise.

We are sensitive to the impact of increased costs. To help us to control our overall costs, a handful of volunteers have continued their commitment to perform all maintenance on the club's machines. New Pistol/Short Range Bays: Due to high usage and popularity of matches and shoots, the Board of Trustees (BOT) has approved funding to build 5 additional Pistol bays just south of the 100 yard range. Construction should begin in late September or early October. Soil required to build these bays will come from east of the 200 yard mound in a portion of the area clear cut last year. This will leave us an additional small pond when complete.

Reminder to Club Members: Hunting seasons are upon us and due to the fact that we are a multifunction club, please be aware of your surroundings while involved with club activities. If using trails or hunting be aware that others my be in the woods. Watch out for fellow members. Wearing of Hunter orange is recommended whenever practical.

Additional Water for Campers: The BOT approved funding for additional water hydrants to be installed around the camping area. This work has been completed and hydrants are in service. All labor was done by club members. A big thank you to all who were involved in this project.

Woods & Trails Committee: We have established a Committee to develop plans to improve access to our woods by improving or building trails in selected areas of our property. Work began with a trail on the Shaughnessy Woods property and one from the camping area to the rear (west edge) of our property. These trails are now ready for your use.
