Range Safety: There have been several reports of members hearing bullets passing through the trees beyond the ranges. Also, there is evidence (ruts from bullet impacts) of members placing targets on or near the ground. When the bullets strike the ground they are skipping off and going over the berm. YOU are responsible for every round that you fire! Make sure that your bullets pass through your target and safely impact the berm. Please use the target stands provided and do not use the target stands as targets.
