# Tannerite is Banned on the Club Grounds

The Board of Trustees approved a motion to ban the use of Tannerite on club grounds. Please do not use this product on the club grounds as it is illegal to possess once it has been mixed. Under Ohio Law, it is considered Dangerous Ordnance after mixing and it is a Class 2 Felony. See Ohio Revised Code 2923.11

The Picture below was taken at the 200 Yard range and shows the damage done by this product.



Do not shoot at any storage cylinders. This includes Propane Tanks, gas tanks, or compressed gas cylinders. The cylinder pictured on the right was found on a 50 yard bay.
