Rules:

1. All firearms must be inspected and zip-tied before entering buildings. Zip ties must remain in place while on the premises.

Tear down 4:00 to 5:00 PM Premises must be clear by 5:00 PM.

- 2. No loaded firearms (except for valid CCW holders) or loaded magazines are permitted. Firearms SHALL NOT have detachable magazines inserted at any time.
- 3. No black powder or explosive devices are permitted on the premises.
- 4. Handguns may be sold only to Ohio residents over the age of 21 and long guns only to Ohio residents over the age of 18. Out of state resident sales should be handled through an FFL due to varying laws in other states. Sellers are responsible to verify the age and residency of buyers by demanding valid photo identification. Ask the buyer "Are you legally able to purchase firearms?"
- 5. Vendors selling firearms and ammunition must be aware of and follow all federal, Ohio and local regulations governing the transfer of firearms. Beware: you may be asked by an undercover media representative, felon, or minor to make an illegal transfer of a firearm or ammunition. Beware of "Straw Buyers." Transfer firearms only to the intended end user. Remember, the ATF may walk among us.
- 6. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
