Shooters on the 50 yard ranges have been parking. Non-members are welcome. observed shooting targets on or near the . ground sending ricocheting bullets into the trees north of the ranges and east of the 200 yard range or set so high that the bullets go over the berm. **Range Safety Course:** The range safety course, required for all members who wish to use the rifle and pistol ranges, are conducted on the 2nd Sunday of every month at 12:00 Noon. Members need attend only once. Upon completion of this course, a green badge will be issued and then you may use the ranges.

All Ranges: There are minimum distances on the ranges where you may place your targets. The minimums are: 200 yards on the 300 yard range, 125 yards on the 200 yard range and 25 yards on the 100 yard range. If your target on the 100 yard or 50 yard bays doesn't result in the bullet striking the back berm, then set your target so that you are shooting into a side berm. This is acceptable and perfectly safe. You may also set the targets at the back berm and move into the bay and shoot from your desired distance. Alternatively, you may use the Pistol Bays.
