

Bird Dog Challenge (BDC)

Three (3) bird event.

POINT SYSTEM:

One point awarded for each of the following

- Each bird found
- Each bird pointed or flushed
- Each bird shot
- Each bird retrieved

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Flushing dogs must flush bird to receive a point for a flush.

Pointing dogs must hold point for a minimum of 3 seconds to score one point.

A dog picking up a bird and walking towards handler, with the bird in the mouth half-way, will count as a retrieve for one point.

A limit of two shells per bird will be allowed, to be furnished by the hunter. No magnum shells permitted, must be 5 shot or smaller (shells will be checked).

Blaze orange must be worn at all times while in the field.

Extra birds will be put out for the first brace.

Running will not be permitted at any time.

Hunter and Dog must stay within the boundaries. Dog and hunter leaving the boundaries will result in loss of retrieval points and bird shot points.

Only shock collars and bells are allowed, NO EXCEPTIONS (no placement beeper collars).

Time will stop when dog is leashed, and last bird is in hand.

Hunters will be notified by phone or text prior to day of event.
