## **Chukar Challenge**

Rules and Regulations:
A team will consist of one or two hunters, and one dog.
All dogs must be on a leash when not in the field
Blaze orange must be worn, at all times.
All hunters must arrive at check in table 1 hour prior to run
birds released for the 1 <sup>st</sup> brace and birds thereafter. Birds will not be hobbled.
Each hunt will last a maximum of 20 minutes. The clock is not stopped until the bird is in the hand of the hunter and both hunters have crossed back over the starting line.
Positively NO running in the field
Only 2 shells per bird will be allowed. SHELLS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED. No magnum shells permitted, must be 5 shot or smaller (shells will be checked).
Hunters cannot cross the shooting preserve lines at any time
Only shock collars and bells are allowed, NO EXCEPTIONS (no placement beeper collars).
For any unforeseen situations which may arise the decision of the marshals will be final.
Dead birds are not permitted to be left in the field. All birds are to be carried by hunters at all times.
Birds trapped by the dog are counted for points, however two shells will be taken by the field marshal for each trapped bird.
NO SHOOTING OF BIRDS ON THE GROUND AT ANY TIME, A PENALITY OF 100 POINTS WILL BE ASSESSED.
Purse: Determined by number of entries. Prize for first place flushing class and pointing class.
Point Systems:  For each bird bagged 10 Points For each shell not used 4 Points For each minute under 15 minutes 4 points (1 point for each 15 seconds)
IN CASE OF A TIE, BEST TIME WILL DETERMINE WINNER.
