Please remember, there is a \$25 late fee on dues not received by **December 31, 2025**.

If you were unable to fulfill your work obligation and have a valid medical reason for not doing so, please include a note from your doctor stating why you should be exempted from the work party requirement. This must be done annually. You may also come before the board of Trustees to request a permanent exemption.

Also, if you are age 70 or older, you may be exempted from the work requirement by showing proof of age to the club secretary or send in a copy of your Drivers License or Birth Certificate with your dues.

THE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING will be held on Sunday, March 15, 2026 in the Main clubhouse starting at 1:00 PM. Please bring treats to share with your fellow members at the meeting.
