**NEW 300 YARD RIFLE:** The club is in the process of building a 300 yard range adjacent to the 200 yard range, trees were cleared and sold to help offset the cost. A contractor has been selected to level the grounds, build mounds and improve drainage. We will also be doing some drainage work on the 100 & 200 yard range and completing the extension work on the pistol bays. Plans are to have all the work completed, including seeding, by mid September so the ranges will be ready prior to hunting season.

**The Board of Trustees** are still considering plans to build a 5-Stand range between the pistol bays and the skeet range. We hope to get some additional grant money in 2006 to purchase the machines necessary for this course. The cost of this project was outside of our budget for 2005.

The Board of Trustees would again like to encourage members to practice "Catch and Release" when fishing at the pond. We would like to keep the numbers of Bass and Bluegill high enough for kids to have a easy and fun time catching fish.

**HUNTING ON CLUB GROUNDS:** Please remember the following rules while hunting on club grounds. Only members and family members can hunt, NO guests. Anyone hunting must follow all Ohio game laws and possession limits. No Sunday hunting is allowed East of the swale and old duck pond. No waterfowl hunting is allowed on the main pond.
